I have read the below ***Conditions of the Tiyamike Sewing Program*** and ***Expectations of Students*** and communicated this to the applicant.

Conditions of the Tiyamike Sewing Program:

Classes are offered free of charge to successful applicants.

Applicants are chosen prayerfully based on their level of need. Applicants will be interviewed in person prior to acceptance.

Students will attend class two mornings a week for nine months with breaks.

Classes begin with a Bible reading and prayer.

Classes are conducted in Chichewa.

Applicants are permitted to bring small children but are expected to care for them during class. Fold up baby cots and baby toys are available.

Students will be given small amounts of sewing work during the course of their learning and receive payment, of which part will be kept and put towards their sewing machine which they will receive on Graduation Day at the end of the nine-month program.

Students are not to resell their sewing machine after graduation. Should Tiyamike Sewing learn of intentions to do so, machine will immediately be reclaimed by Tiyamike Sewing.

Expectations of Students

Be committed to attend class two mornings a week (9-12pm).

Be committed to completing the entire nine-month program.

Provide own transport to the minibus stage where they will be picked up by the Tiyamike Sewing school bus.

Notify teachers if they are unable to attend class.

Treat Tiyamike Sewing property, teachers, and other students with respect.

Failure to comply may result in removal from the program, though every effort will be made to help students overcome hurdles that may hinder their learning.
